IP3 ENGLISH LITERATURE 2 2023 SYLLABUS AND ASSESSMENT

Here is an overview of what to expect for your Literature 2 syllabus and assessment this year. Some of this information might change over the course of the year; if so, your Literature tutor will keep you informed.

There are two texts studied:

• IP3 English Literature Practical Criticism Reader

We will be learning about literary techniques used in poetry, prose and drama, and applying our knowledge to understand unseen texts in these genres.

IP3 English Literature Intertextuality Reader

We will be learning about how literary texts influence and are influenced by other texts, and applying our knowledge to compare story structures, characters and tropes in fairy tales and mythology.

Literature 2 End of Year Examinations (60%)

The EOY is **2 hours** (50 marks total) and comprises

- 1 seen poem vs. unseen poem comparison (25 marks)
- 1 essay comparison question (choose 2 out of 4 texts)
